International Theme: The Time is NOW! "Agree to Differ" on Friday, May 3 at 1:00 p.m. Bethel Baptist Church. Salad Luncheon provided. No charge to attend, but donations are accepted!



We will be recognizing two Valiant Women at this meeting. Please remember to bring your church's **International Fellowship of the Least Coin (IFLC)** donations to be gathered at this meeting. IFLC is an ecumenical movement of prayers for peace and reconciliation. Each time a woman prays for justice, peace, and reconciliation she sets aside the least coin of her currency. Each year 35-50 projects are awarded Least Coin grants globally. You can view them at <u>http://www.flc.net.ph/</u>. For example, in 2018 the Community Presbyterian Church of Charlestown, IN, was awarded \$4000 for D.I.A.P.E.R. (Diapering Infants and Providing Emergency Resources) Project – which aims to provide diapers and other essential baby items to low-income families in their area. A second example is the awarding of \$2500 to WOCOTOMADI (World Coming Together to Make a Difference) First Rural Women Farm Project Cameroon, Africa. That grant provides healthcare, and promotes agricultural yield of farms, and health and education.

Our program this year will celebrate human rights, and the program will follow the international CWU's program guidelines. Reservations are NOT required.

Recall that this is the meeting at which we celebrate the Human Rights Award recipient. This year's recipient is The Foodbank, Inc., which provides food to the food pantries and individuals in need from three counties: Montgomery, Greene, and Preble. <u>QUESTION</u>: Why is there a new form for individual memberships?

ANSWER: Going to the full-page format is advantageous for several reasons! First, this form can be emailed easily in a fillable format. It can be found on-line quickly from any computer. The forms are available NOW for 2019—2020 without waiting for printing and distribution at the August board meeting. AND There is a savings in printing costs!

<u>QUESTION</u>: What does "fillable format" mean?

<u>ANSWER</u>: Fillable format means that when you open the form on a computer, you can type in all the blank lines. Then you can fill out the form and print it. Give the form to your Key Woman.

<u>QUESTION</u>: Do I have to fill out the form on a computer before I print it?

<u>ANSWER</u>: No, you may just open the form, print it, fill it out by hand, and give it to your Key Woman.

The Women's Association at Sugar Creek Presbyterian Church has helped support mission trips to the Dominican Republic for many years. Members Marylou Somogyi and Barbara Neyhouse, have gone on these week long mission trips nine (9) times and four (4) times respectively. For all of these trips, the Women's Association has donated generously to help the people of the Dominican Republic. Many times, the donation went to Monte Cristo, a very primitive nursing home. Other times, including this year, money has gone to improve the lives of the women and girls at the Lily House, a home to shelter those who are recovering from different types of sexual abuse.

SPECIAL NOTE from Eleanor Jerman: At the most recent (2018) General Assembly (Presbyterian Church of the U.S.A.), the following action was approved: The 223rd General Assembly commends the "Letter from Birmingham City Jail," written by Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., to the church for study, as a resource that provides prophetic witness that inspires, challenges, and educates both church and world, and furthermore, to begin the process outlined in G6.03 to include it in the Book of Confessions. (The Book of Confessions is Part 1 of the PCUSA's Constitution; The Book of Order is the other.) Sugar Creek Presbyterian Church is currently doing a six-week study of Dr. King's letter, the
