

BREAKFAST HIGHLIGHTS

Emma Murray, past president of CWU in Greater Dayton from 1977-1979, dreamed of an area-wide prayer breakfast to be held annually in Dayton. CWU in Greater Dayton has continued that practice over the years. We believe that prayers can be prayer anywhere, and that the power of corporate prayer is phenomenal!

The Emma Murray Prayer Breakfast has been held annually for 43 years close to World Day of Prayer. Keynote speaker was Ms. Janny Kehr, Nurse Practitioner, Advance Practice Registered Nurse, Certified Nurse Practitioner in Primary Care in Long Term Care and Assisted Living Facilities. She spoke on three areas of health on which women need to focus and gave scriptures to support each. The three areas are: 1) Mental Health – using Romans 12:2 and Philippians 4:8; 2) Health of the Body – using Psalm 39:13-16; and 3) Spirit always points to the Lord. Through God we become forgivers. Good spiritual health leads to good emotions. Forgiving others benefits our health. Mark 11:25 and I John 1:9. Ms. Kehr gave us much to think about. More of her presentation will be shared at a later date.

The World Day of Prayer Offering received thus far is \$190.00. The Fellowship of the Least Coin Offering received thus far is \$752.01. We are very grateful to all who have contributed. Those funds will be sent to the national office so that can benefit women who have specific project needs around the world.

CHURCH WORLD SERVICE (CWS) UPDATES

Once again, our world is in a crisis situation and in need of much prayer and help. Our hearts are broken for the people in Ukraine. I received email from Matthew Stevens of CWS about sending blankets to Ukraine. CWS deployed a small team of experts to Romania and Moldova to assess the situation on the ground. The results of this assessment will inform how CWS will expand assistance such as providing resources like blankets, hygiene kits and other humanitarian supplies. One suggestion was that some churches might like to have a Blanket Sunday. The materials can be ordered from CWS to do this. We will continue to make up Church Women United hygiene and school kits. I don't have a collection date yet but know it will be after September 1, 2022. The lists for both kits are the same as last year and can be found on Church Women United website. We have much work to do along with a lot of prayer. Thank you for your faithful service.
