2022 HUMAN RIGHTS RECIPIENT

At June 6 2022 Church Women United Human Rights Day the recipient was Miami Valley Meals (MVM). This group was formerly called Set the Banquet Table. It recovers and transforms donated food into meals which are distributed through a network of nonprofit partner organizations that feed the hungry. This two year old group has a staff of 17. Since March 2020, 350,000 meals were prepared. Approximately 4000 meals a week are served with St. Vincent Homeless Shelter and Catholic Services receiving many of the meals.



President's Message from Jerri Wood...

1. Quadrennial Priorities 2021-2024: These priorities were prepared by the National CWU Actions/Global Committee. The theme is "Justice and Righteousness" using the Principles of God's Word in Micah 6:8.

- #1 Health and Wellness (Matthew 9:12-13) focusing on health equity.
- #2 Climate Stewardship (Job 12:7-10) particularly about Environmental Equity.
- #3 Social Justice (John 2:14-17) with a focus on racial justice
- #4 Hunger and Poverty (Psalm 72:4) as women of faith we strive for a just society.

2. We will have our Board meetings at 960 West Dorothy Lane at Dorothy Lane American Baptist Church. At 1:00 p.m.

What is the same this year?

1. We will have Board meetings for all Key women and interested members on the fourth Tuesday at 1:00 p.m. in August, September, October, February, April and May. Celebrations will be held in November, December, March, May and June at local churches.

2. Our web site: www.cwu.daytonoh.org has so much information to share with you. Please check it out. We are thankful to our communications chairperson, Martha Shields, for creating and maintaining this communication tool. Our national Church Women United site also has many ideas for your local churches (churchwomenunited.net.)

3. We ask each church to send a representative (Key Woman) to our board meetings to learn about activities and ministries in the Dayton Metro area. Since the pandemic, we have lost members and churches that were involved. Please renew your interest and activity in CWU!

4. At each meeting there will be a local ministry sharing about their current needs and ministry. We start with Mercy Manor in August.

We continue to trust God in leading us in our movement (Proverbs 3:5 – "*Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight. In all your ways acknowledge him and he will make straight your paths.*") We know that by trusting God to guide our paths we can achieve our purpose: **to encourage church women to come together in a visible fellowship to witness to their faith in Jesus Christ and, enabled by the Holy Spirit to go out together into every neighborhood and nation as instruments of God's reconciling love.** Let us trust each day and put our lives in the master's hands.
