

EAST CENTRAL REGION 2022 CONFERENCE OF CWU



Church Women United Inc. East Central Region 2022
Conference was held on October 20-22, 2022 in Indianapolis,
Indiana. The theme was "It is Up to Us to Serve, Pray, and Act."
CWU Indiana State Unit hosted the event with true hospitality and efficiency. Barbara McCoy, Registrar and President of CWU
Indiana State reported that 119 women from Church Women United organizations in Michigan, Indiana, Ohio, Illinois, and Kentucky registered.
The energy level was high from the moment the women arrived at the Drury Plaza Hotel in Carmel, Indiana until the moment the women departed!!

Norma Borgmann (right), East Central Regional Coordinator, and her team were the only CWU Regional Team that planned an in-person Regional Conference for 2022! Conference highlights include:

- Inspirational Bible Study (Many thanks to Margaret Hunt, VP CWU in Greater Dayton for serving as a Bible Study leader);
- Informative presentation about characteristics of young women and how to attract them to CWU;
- Hands-on Mission Project with Church World Service, in which a large group of women packed 430 Menstrual Hygiene Kits to be distributed in parts of the world where girls live in poverty and do not have access to feminine care supplies;
- Workshop on Health and Wellness that had the participants write an "I AM" Poem which produced some wonderful poems in only 30 minutes;
- Singing by CWU choir throughout the weekend;
- Opportunity for each state to meet in separate groups to share news and plans for state CWU;
- Hearing from the National CWU President Mira J. Washington; and
- Spirit-filled atmosphere and connecting with wonderful CWU regional members.

Ohio had eleven persons in attendance, and five of those were from the Dayton area. It is my prayer that more members of CWU in Greater Dayton will be able to attend in future years. The experience was uplifting and helped to connect me with the wonderful outreach that is being done by CWU in our region. Let us remember that "We are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do." Ephesians 2:10 NIV



Fellowship of the Least Coin

One of our CWU projects each year is to collect coins for The Fellowship of the Least Coin (FLC) Offering. FLC is a worldwide ecumenical movement of prayer and reconciliation. We collect our donations at the May Friendship Day Celebration, which for this year is on Saturday, May 20 at 1:00 p.m. at Corinthian Baptist Church, 700 South James H. McGee Blvd. in Dayton.

As Christian women around the world meet and pray with each other, they are reminded to live a forgiving life with others. "Least coins" are given with each prayer. The movement is focused on prayer and reconciliation rather than money. Anyone who wishes to do so, makes a commitment to spend time in prayer whenever she has a strained relationship with another person, and to uphold in prayer others who are victims of jealousy, hatred, violence and injustice.

Women world-wide set aside one "least coin" of her currency as a tangible token toward her prayer being answered. These coins are sent regularly to her country's FLC collection point, where the collection is forwarded to the FLC Fund. The amount collected by each country is never publicized; only the total sum collected each year is announced. The idea for the Fellowship of the Least Coin (FLC) logo came from the late Rayann Ma from Hong Kong, the first Chairperson of the first assembly of the Asian Church Women's Conference (ACWC). The actual design was gifted by her brother-in-law, James Ma, who was a commercial artist.

The logo includes 6 folded hands in prayer that encircle a small plum flower. The hands are different colours to represent people of all backgrounds. Together, these praying hands form the image of a lotus flower.

The lotus plant grows in muddy ponds but its flower rises above the murky water and opens beautifully, without blemish. In the same spirit, although women and girls all over the world face oppression and injustices of many kinds, with prayer and support they, too, can rise above these circumstances with dignity and grace.
